CASBS - Residential Fellowship Program 2025/2026

Descrição

The Center for Advanced Study in the Behavioral Sciences (CASBS) (https://casbs.stanford.edu/) was founded more than sisty years ago and has been home to Nobel, Pulitzer, and MacArthur Fellowship winners. ASBS continues to build on its original mission of "advancing human welfare" by generating "knowledge for the maximum benefit of individuals and society.

The Center offers a Residential Fellowship Program (https://casbs.stanford.edu/apply-casbs-fellowship) for scholars working in a diverse range of disciplines that contribute to advancing research and thinking in social science. Fellows represent the core social and behavioral sciences (anthropology, economics, history, political science, psychology, and sociology) but also the humanities, education, linguistics, communications, and the biological, natural, health, and computer sciences.

Elegibilidade

Candidates must be a highly accomplished academic or thinker (relative to career stage) who:

- 1. Has a PhD, professional degree (such as JD, MD), an equivalent foreign degree, or has achieved an equivalent level of professional reputation;
- 2. Is three to four years past the doctorate or equivalent degree (CASBS does not offer post-doctoral fellowships);
- 3. Is an academic faculty member- or an independent researcher who exhibits a high level of achievement (adjusted for rank), including a strong record of research publications;
- 4. Communicates clearly in English;
- 5. Is someone who is very interested in participating in regular interdisciplinary conversations;
- 6. Is willing to commit to being in residence for the course of the fellowship year without conflicting commitments.

Note: In addition to scholars working in fields of the behavioral and social sciences, those in other areas will also be considered for fellowships if their work has human behavioral and social dimensions.

Valor Financiado

1. A Center stipend is based on the fellow's salary for the year before residence. (Nine-month salary for an academic; 12-month salary for a non-academic.)

2. That stipend cannot exceed one-half of the fellow's base salary for that year and is additionally subject to an upper limit set by the CASBS board of directors.

- 3. The cap is currently set at \$82,000, but may increase slightly. The sum of the fellow's salary from a home institution or affiliation and a Center stipend may not exceed the fellow's base salary for the fellowship year.
- 4. Because of the high cost of living in the Stanford University area, the Center has established a minimum salary for those who are offered a fellowship. Under certain circumstances and conditional on the guidelines above, fellows earning less than \$100,000 per year may receive a stipend that exceeds the standard 50% maximum contribution.
- 5. Fellows receive their stipend payments directly; the Center cannot assign a fellow's stipend to a third party or institution.
