
Swiss National Science Foundation - Postdoctoral Fellowships 2024

Descrição

Based on a government mandate, the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) (<https://www.snf.ch/en>) supports scientific research in all academic disciplines, from history to medicine and the engineering sciences. At the end of 2019, the SNSF was funding 5750 projects involving 18,900 researchers, which makes it the leading Swiss institution for promoting scientific research.

Switzerland is considered a non-associated third country in the 2024 calls for projects in Horizon Europe (work programme 2023-2025) and related programmes and initiatives. This year, on behalf of the Swiss Confederation, the SNSF is launching a new call under the transitional measure SNSF Swiss Postdoctoral Fellowships

(https://www.snf.ch/media/en/1JaseDUMfNixyypD/Call_Document_Swiss_Postdoctoral_Fellowships_2024.pdf) for people of all nationalities who were aiming to apply for a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Postdoctoral Fellowship (MSCA PF).

In principle, the SNSF Swiss Postdoctoral Fellowship is awarded for a continuous stay in Switzerland of 12-24 months. It is possible, however, to conduct short research stays at different host institutions for the maximum total duration of one third of the SNSF Swiss Postdoctoral Fellowship. These additional host institutions can either be higher education institutions or institutions operating in applied fields (industry, administration, etc; intersectoral mobility). During the period spent at another host institution, the grantee remains employed at the host institution in Switzerland.

Elegibilidade

1. Submitted by researchers of any nationality from all disciplines.
2. At the time of submission deadline, applicants must hold a doctoral degree (PhD) to be eligible as postdoctoral researchers.
3. Applicants who have defended their doctoral thesis but not yet formally been awarded the doctoral degree will also be considered postdoctoral researchers and eligible. An official document confirming that they have successfully passed the doctoral exam is required.
4. At the time of submission deadline, proposals must be submitted within 8 years after the obtainment of the relevant degree, i.e. the doctoral degree (PhD). The relevant date is that of the examination or thesis defence.

5. This time window may be extended if one or more of the reasons set out in Clause 1.11 of the General implementation regulations for the Funding Regulations are met. The reasons for extending the time window must be outlined in the proposal.

Valor Financiado

With the Swiss Postdoctoral Fellowships, the SNSF covers the recipients salary and social security costs. Calculated on a full-time basis, the annual gross salary of the postdoc, excluding social security contributions by the employer (host institution), lies within the following range:

CHF 80,000 to 105,000.

In addition to the recipients' salary, project funds, including research costs directly linked to the implementation of the project, training and networking contributions, are also covered. Project funds must not exceed CHF 24,000 for a two-year grant. If the duration of the SNSF Swiss Postdoctoral Fellowship is less than 2 years, the maximum amount will be proportionately smaller.
